Hong Kong Scootering & Roller Freestyle Selection 2025

Competition Details

- Introduction : **Hong Kong Scootering & Roller Freestyle Selection 2025** is organized for Hong Kong scooter and roller freestyle athletes. This competition will be held on October 12, 2025, to select representatives for the Hong Kong team to participate in the World Championships in Japan on November 21, 2025.
- Objective :
1. Our organization, “Hong Kong Federation of Extreme Sports”, as a partner of the China Hong Kong Roller Sports and Skateboarding Federation, hopes to select outstanding or potential athletes through the competition. Those who perform well and are recommended by the head coach may have the opportunity to be selected to represent Hong Kong in the upcoming World Skate World Championships in Japan.
 2. Provide a platform for Hong Kong scooter and roller freestyle athletes to participate and learn from each other.
 3. Allow local athletes to experience official competitions.
 4. Enable the public to gain a deeper understanding of the sport by watching the competitions.
- Eligibility : Participants must be permanent residents of Hong Kong, hold a Hong Kong SAR passport, or have lived in Hong Kong continuously for more than 2 years and be amateur athletes.
- Date : **October 12, 2025 (Sunday)**
- Tentative Time : Start at 2pm
- Tentative Athlete Meeting : 1:30pm
- Venue : Skateboard ground at Kwok Shui Road Park
- Judges and Officials : Appointed by the Hong Kong Federation of Extreme Sports
- Category : Aged 5* or above (Men / Women)
**Participants must be 5 year-old or above on the competition day.*
- Quota : No limit for the Open
- Event : Street
- Enrollment Fee : HK\$150 / each event
- *Please submit both Enrollment Form, identity document and the Fee, late applications and incomplete enrollment forms will not be accepted.*
 - *Acknowledgement email will be sent to the participant within 7 working days. Please contact our staff if you did not receive any emails.*
 - *The Enrollment Fee is non-refundable in case of withdrawal.*
- Enrollment Deadline : **10 October, 2025 (Friday), 5:00pm**
- Competition Schedule : Information will be posted to our Official Website on or before 8th October, 2025.
(Please also read the updated announcement through the Official Website and Competition Day.)
- Safety Equipment : Helmets are mandatory for persons under 18.
- Appeal : Once competition scores are approved by the Head Judge and published, they are final and not subject to any appeal.
- Important notes :
1. Athletes shall report to the competition office on time. Latecomers will be considered as withdrawing, and they cannot participate in the competition and the Enrollment Fee is non-refundable.
 2. All Athletes have duties and responsibilities as shown below,
 - ♦ Athletes shall acquaint themselves with the competition area and obstacles by warming up and practicing on the spot.
 - ♦ Athletes shall respect and accept the judge’s judgement and all rules and regulations. If a competitor who fails to follow the rules and regulations, he/she will be disqualified immediately.
 3. Please refer to latest information posted on the Official Website, the poster and Event Day, especially the date of Final. Individual announcement will not be made.
 4. All Athletes have to follow the "Players' Guide" set by the venue.
 5. If there is any inconsistency or ambiguity between the English version and the Chinese version, the English version shall prevail.
 6. HKFRS reserves the right to decline any enrollment and modify the above information without notice.

Rules and Regulations

All scooter and inline skating (street) events will adopt the following rules:

Selection Format

- Run** – All events will have two rounds. Each participant gets at least two 60-second “Runs.” Judges score each Run from 0.00 to 100. The highest and lowest scores are discarded, the rest are averaged (to two decimal places). The participant’s best Run score is the final result.

Tie-Break

- The score from the best run decides the Tie-break.
- If still tied, the score from the best single trick attempt breaks the tie.
- If still tied, judges will be asked to vote on who is first.
- In the case of several ties, the judges will be asked again to vote for the second-best, etc.

Judging Panel and Criteria

- Three (3) judges, plus one (1) head judge who oversees the competition.
- The head judge does not provide a score.
- In such case where there are only two (2) judges (minimum), the head judge will provide a score.
- Judges score each run based on five (5) criteria’s: Difficulty and Variety of Performed Tricks, Quality of Execution, Use of Course and individual Obstacles, Flow and Consistency and Repetition.

Tentative Practice and Warm up session arrangement

- 20-30 minutes practice time will be arranged before the competition start. Athletes may be divided into groups if necessary.
- 5 minutes warm up time prior to the competition of each designated category.
- Competition Schedule will be post to our Official Website on or before 10 October, 2025
